



FARTHINGSTONE FOOT FEST

Saturday 18th June 2022

The Course:

The full Challenge course covers just over 26 miles and consists of two loops, based around the village, forming a figure of eight route which is almost entirely on footpaths and trails with minimal road usage. The course covers stretches of the Macmillan Way, Knightly Way and Nene Way with connecting footpaths through the wonderful rolling countryside of Northamptonshire.

If the full course is too challenging, entrants may complete either one of the loops:

- The first loop is 15 miles but Checkpoint 3 is at the 13-mile point for those wishing to limit their distance to a half marathon (pick-up is available but may have to wait until the vehicle is free).
- The second loop is 11 miles. Entries are limited to later start times to allow for checkpoint set-ups.

There are 7 checkpoints on the route and refreshments are available at each. The checkpoints will close through the day with the latest at 18.00 and 'late' walkers/runners will be asked to retire if they are deemed unable to reach the end within the times.

Start times:

26 mile: walkers start 08.00 onwards; runners 09.00 onwards
last entries walkers 10.30, runners 11.00

13 & 15 mile: walkers & runners start 09.15 onwards
last entries walkers 10.30, runners 11.00

11 mile: walkers & runners start 11.30 onwards
last entries walkers 1 pm, runners 1.30pm

Entry fee:

26 mile events: £20.00 (£23.00 on day)
15, 13 or 11 mile: £17.00 (£20.00 on day)

Full details and final instructions will be sent together with comprehensive route descriptions, a map identifying the start location, parking and your entry number 1 week in advance of the event.
